INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

Clean the nail and remove any traces of nail polish before each application. Use the applicator to coat the whole nail and the underside of the nail rim with the product. Apply generously to affected area, twice a day for one minute (once in the morning, once in the evening). Allow the nail to dry for 33 seconds before putting on socks and/or shoes. Make sure the applicator is fully closed after each treatment to prevent evaporation. For best results, treat the infected area with Excilor® for a minimum of three months. Continue to use until the nail has recovered completely.

What is fungal nail infection?

Fungal nail infection (also known as onychomycosis) refers to infection of the toe or finger nails by fungi (dermatophytes). The infection usually starts at the rim of the nail, which changes colour to whitish-yellow, brown or green.

The fungus grows under or into the nail, causing the nail plate to thicken and crumble. Sometimes the nail becomes partially or completely detached, which may be painful. In some cases the nail will come away from the toe or finger.

How do you get fungal nail infection?

Nails - most commonly toenails - are infected by fungus due to excessive moisture, heat, perspiration or possibly poor hygiene. Normally the nail plate is too thick for fungi to penetrate. However, damaged nails can easily become infected. Shoes that are too tight and/or feet that perspire provide conditions for fungi to develop and spread. Fungal infections are contagious and can be passed onto others (e.g. by using communal showers). Self-contamination is also possible: the infection can spread from one nail to another. Some people (diabetics, patients on corticosteroids, patients with compromised immune systems) are more prone to fungal infections. It is important to treat the fungal nail infection as soon as possible: the smaller the infected area, the shorter the period of treatment. Swift treatment can also prevent the infection from spreading to other nails.

How do you prevent fungal nail infection?

- Wash your feet regularly. If soap is used, rinse your feet thoroughly afterwards to remove all traces of the soap.
- Dry your feet thoroughly, especially between the toes.
- Wear clean cotton or woollen socks.
- Wear shoes that allow your feet to "breathe" and are not too tight.
- Change your shoes regularly.
- Use an antifungal product in your shoes.
- Wear sandals in areas where a lot of people walk barefoot, for example in communal showers, changing rooms and swimming pools.

It is highly recommended to start nail fungus treatment as soon as it is diagnosed.

Excilor® is clinically formulated to penetrate through the tough nail surface. Results are visible as soon as the healthy new nail grows back.

Fungal nail infections grow into and inside the nail and are very difficult to reach and to treat. **Excilor®** was specifically developed to treat fungal nail infections and is based on 3 principles:

1 **Effective mode of action:**

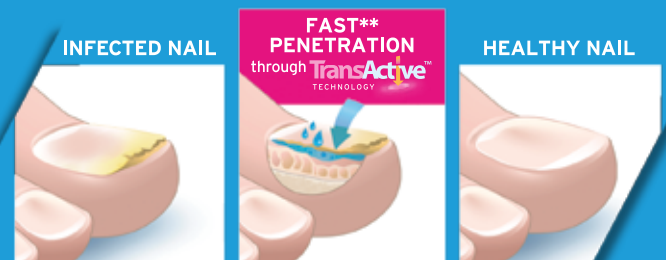
Excilor® changes the pH level inside the nail, creating a hostile environment for fungi (dermatophytes). This inhibits further growth of the fungi and any further damage to the nails.

2 **Due to the unique TransActive™ Penetrative Technology, Excilor® is able to penetrate the nail**

therefore ensuring the nail is treated from the inside out. It usually takes a few months before an affected nail looks completely healthy again.

3 **Convenience:**

Excilor® is easy to apply, no need to file the nail. Effective treatment requires compliance to the treatment regime: 1 x in the morning and 1 x in the evening, in total 1 minute a day.
